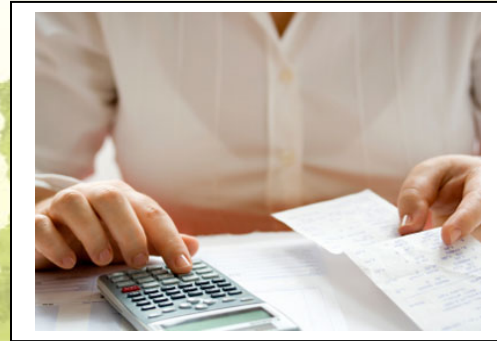
How to Write a Successful Section 330 Grant Application
